Sycamores benefits from a salon offering hairdressing and manicures, and gardens with lawn and bedding plants, as well as paved areas, a cycle path for their side-by-side bike for two, and a summer house.

The home also uses circadian lighting, a system that mimics natural daylight to set the body's internal body clock, helping residents to be more alert during the day and sleep better at night.
